## 2024 Au Gres Farm Market Stall Rental Rules

The Market is intended to offer fresh fruits, vegetables, flowers/plants, honey/maple syrup products, and baked goods to area residents. The sale of other products is prohibited without prior permission.

The NMRFM will be open Mondays from 8 - 1 in Au Gres beginning June 3, 2024. The market will stay open as long as vendors have product to sell EBT/SNAP/Food Stamp Friendly STALLS OPEN AT 7 AM MONDAYS

**NO EARLY UNLOADING** 

- 1. Vendors must comply with all city, state and county licensing /sanitary regulations. Baked goods and/or prepared foods sold at Market must be produced in a licensed location for resale in the State of Michigan or follow Cottage Food Law.
- 2. Each vendor must clean up the debris around his/her stall at the end of each market day and dispose of trash. Failure to comply will result in a \$50 cleanup fee, which must be paid before attendance on another market day.
- 3. Each vendor is required to display a sign inside their tent that clearly identifies their operation. Any wholesale tables will be identified and labeled. Additionally, we require labeling that clearly shows what the products are, where they were produced, and their price. Please remember that good labeling provides an important opportunity for each vendor
- 4. There will be no baskets, crates, or people standing in stalls to hold them for later arrival of people or vehicles. Stalls will be assigned by Market Master.
- 5. Vendors may park trucks, trailers or other vehicles ONLY in their rented stalls.
- 6. Vendors must have their stall completely set-up within their assigned market area and ready for operation at the scheduled opening of the market. Vendors reporting late to the market must unload goods outside the market for safety reasons. No sales after market closes.
- 7. Vendors shall not vacate the market before the official closing time for any reason without the express permission of the Market Master.
- 8. Vendors will remain courteous of other vendors and customers and will follow the Market guidelines.
- The Farm Market assumes no liability for injuries or damage incurred by vendors or shoppers arising out of the conduct of the Market vendors.
- 10. Selling of crafts is prohibited unless approved by the Market Committee.
- 11. The Market Master, under the authority of the NMRFM Board, shall have full charge of enforcing all NMRFM Rules and Regulations. It will be the Market Master's responsibility to make decisions if special circumstances should arise.
- 12. Anyone not complying with these Rules, Regulations and the Application will be notified. Three notifications will result in suspension of market privileges.
