

AMENDMENT TO HOUSE TRAILER ORDINANCE

CITY OF AUGRES

ORDINANCE NO. 19

The City of AuGres hereby ordains that Section I of House Trailer Ordinance No. 16, of July 8, 1966, be and hereby is amended and re-enacted to read as follows:

SECTION I

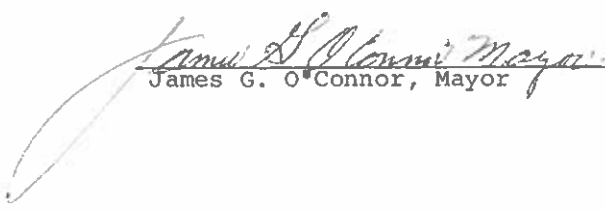
The terms "house car" or "trailer" shall be construed to include any structure or structures used as or intended for sleeping or other living quarters and having no foundation other than wheels, blocks, skids, jacks, horses, or skirtings, or any structure or structures used as or intended for sleeping or other living quarters which is, has been, or reasonably may be equipped with wheels or other devices for transporting the structure or structures from place to place, whether by motor power or other means. Any Component home approved for mortgage financing for a term in excess of 10 years by the Federal Housing Administration, The Farmers Home Administration or The Veterans Administration, and which measures at least 24 feet in width and 48 feet in length, and which is assembled and set up on a permanent foundation, shall not be construed as a "house car" or "trailer".

The remaining portions of Ordinance No. 16 are hereby re-enacted and remain in full force and effect.

This Ordinance shall become effective twenty-one (21) days after its passage. The City Clerk shall cause this Ordinance to be immediately published in the Arenac County Independent.

WE HEREBY CERTIFY that the foregoing Ordinance was duly enacted by the City Council of the City of AuGres on June 4, 1970.
