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AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE USE OF FIREARMS WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF AUCRES, PROVIDING FOR PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF AND PROVIDING THAT INVALIDITY OF PART SHALL NOT AFFECT THE VALIDITY OF THE REMAINING PART:

The City of AUCRES Ordains:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to discharge a firearm, pistol, rifle, or shotgun within the incorporated limits of this city, except as hereinafter provided.

Section 2. The use and discharge of firearms shall be allowed in the protection of life and property.

Section 3. The use and firing of shotguns shall be allowed within the confines of said city limits by persons engaged in hunting small game and deer during that period of time designated by the State of Michigan for hunting of small game and deer with firearms.

Section 4. Any person who shall violate in violation of this ordinance shall upon conviction be punished by a fine not exceeding one hundred and no/100 dollars (\$100.00) or ninety (90) days in jail, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 5. If any section, provision or part thereof in this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction then such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision, or part thereof not so adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.
