

ORDINANCE ADDRESSING FLOODPLAIN MANAGEMENT PROVISIONS OF THE STATE CONSTRUCTION CODE

City of Au Gres, County of Arenac

Ordinance number 11

An ordinance amendment to designate an enforcing agency to discharge the responsibility of the City of Au Gres located in Arenac County, and to designate regulated flood hazard areas under the provisions of the State Construction Code Act, Act No. 230 of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended.

The City of Au Gres ordains:

Section 1. AGENCY DESIGNATED. Pursuant to the provisions of the state construction code, in accordance with Section 8b(6) of Act 230, of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended, the Arenac County Building Department for the City of Au Gres is hereby designated as the enforcing agency to discharge the responsibility of the City of Au Gres under Act 230, of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended, State of Michigan. The Arenac County Building Department assumes responsibility for the administration and enforcement of said Act through out the corporate limits of the community adopting this ordinance.

Section 2. CODE APPENDIX ENFORCED. Pursuant to the provisions of the state construction code, in accordance with Section 8b(6) of Act 230, of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended, Appendix G of the Michigan Building Code shall be enforced by the enforcing agency within the jurisdiction of the community adopting this ordinance.

Section 3. DESIGNATION OF REGULATED FLOOD PRONE HAZARD AREAS. The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Flood Insurance Study (FIS) Entitled "Arenac County, Michigan (All Jurisdictions)" and dated June 15, 2022 and the Flood Insurance Rate Map(s) (FIRMS) panel number(s) of 26011C0255D, effective March 16, 2015 and 26011CIND0B, 26011C0262E, 26011C0264E, 26011C0266E, 26011C0268E effective June 15, 2022 are adopted by reference for the purposes of administration of the Michigan Construction Code, and declared to be a part of Section 1612.3 of the Michigan Building Code, and to

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The City of Au Gres ordains:

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Section 2. CODE APPENDIX ENFORCED. Pursuant to the provisions of the state construction code, in accordance with Section 8b(6) of Act 230, of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended, Appendix G of the Michigan Building Code shall be enforced by the enforcing agency within the jurisdiction of the community adopting this ordinance.

Section 3. DESIGNATION OF REGULATED FLOOD PRONE HAZARD AREAS. The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Flood Insurance Study (FIS) Entitled "Arenac County, Michigan (All Jurisdictions)" and dated March 16, 2015 and the Flood Insurance Rate Map(s) (FIRMS) panel number(s) of 26011C; 0255D, 0262D, 0264D, 0266D, and 0268D dated 3/16/2015 are adopted by reference for the purposes of administration of the Michigan Construction Code, and declared to be a part of Section 1612.3 of the Michigan Building Code, and to provide the content of the "Flood Hazards" section of Table R301.2(1) of the Michigan Residential Code.

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Section 4. REPEALS. All ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

This ordinance duly adopted on March 1, 2022 at a regular meeting of the Au Gres City Council and will become effective immediately.

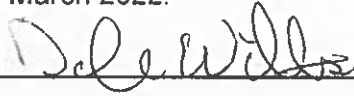
