The City Liquor Control Encrement Department shall insect not less than monthly, all quor establishments licensed uner the Liquor Control Act of the State of Michigan and report the results of all imspections comptly to the Council. inspectors shall have the right to inspect any place in the City where alcoholic liquor is manufactured, sold, offered for sale, kept for sale, possessed or transported, or where the Inspector suspects the same is being thus manufactured, sold, offered for sale, kept for sale, possessed, or transported. Whenever possible, all inspection forms furnished by the Michigan Liquor Control Commission or on similar forms otherwise obtained by the City Liquor Control Enforcement Department.

SECTION 5. Appropriation. For the purpose of carrying out the provisions of this Opdinance and establishing the Uquor Control Enforcement Department herein provided for, the Council hereby appropriates the sum of \$2200.00 for such use, and is hereby authorized and directed to annually appropriate such an amount as will an its discretion, be sufficient to maintain and operate such Liquor Control Enforcement Department for the ensuing fiscal year of the Ofty, not exceeding however, when combined with other general expenses of the City, 15 miles of the assessed valuation of the City in any one year. SECTION 5. Appropriation. in any one year.

SECTION 6. Penalties.

Any person, other than persons required to be licensed under the Michigan Liquor Control Act, who shall violate any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a mirdemeanor.

Any licensee who shall violate any of the provisions of the Michigan Liquor Control Act or any rule or regulation of the Michigan Liquor Control Commission promulgated thereunder, or who shall violate any of the provisions of this Ordinance, and any person who shall prohibit or interfere with the authorized inspection of a member of the City Liquor Control Enforcement Department shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, punishable by imprisonment in the county jail not more than 90 days or by a fine of not more than \$100.00, or both, in the discretion of the court. in the discretion of the court.

Each day that a violation continues to exist shall constitute a separate offense.

It is the intent of the Council that the court, in imposing pun-

shment under the provisions of this Ordinance, should discriminrais Ordinance, should discriminate between casual or slight vio-lations and habitual sales of al-coholic liquor or attempts to com-mercisalize violations of this Or-dinance or any of the rules or regulations of the Michigan Liquor at Control Commission promul-sated under the Michigan Liquor control Act.

SECTION 7. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take offect on the 19th day of March, 1960. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict with any of the provisions of this Ordinance, are hereby repealed.
