ORDINANCE NO. 27

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE THE LOCATION, INSTALLATION, MAINTENANCE
AND OPERATION OF SATELLITE DISH ANTENNAS IN THE
CITY OF AUGRES

THE CITY OF AUGRES ORDAINS:

1. Definition: A satellite dish antenna for purposes of this ordinance shall be construed to be a satellite earth station capable of or designed to receive signals from a satellite rather than from a local broadcasting station. A satellite dish antenna shall also be referred to as a disc antenna or satellite antenna.
2. Location: A satellite dish antenna and anchorage devices shall not be installed within the City of AuGres unless the same is in the rear yard of any lot and may not be located nearer than six feet from a rear or side lot line, and may not be located on or placed upon an easement of any kind. In the event installation of said antenna is upon a corner lot or parcel, the same shall be in the rear yard as above described, but not nearer to the side lot line than the side building line, if extended to the rear line.
3. Height: No satellite disc antenna shall be of a size greater than twelve (12) feet in diameter and shall not rise from ground level in excess of twelve (12) feet in diameter and shall not rise from ground level in excess of twelve (12) feet in height, including the base or other support structures.
4. Miscellaneous: A satellite disc antenna installed for private residential use shall not contain advertising thereon, and a satellite disc antenna utilized in a commercially zoned area of the City shall be subject to any sign ordinance or regulation of the City of AuGres.
5. Violation of this ordinance by any person, partnership, or corporation shall be punishable by a \$100.00 fine and/or 90 days in jail, or both. Each day of continuing violation is deemed to be a separate offense. The City may also seek injunctive relief in Circuit Court for violation of this Ordinance.
6. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon publication thereof.
